The meeting of Internal Quality Assurance Cell was held on 2nd July 2025 at 2 pm in IQAC cell. The meeting was chaired by Hon'ble. Dr. Prashant Warke, Director of Godavari Institute of Management and Research.

At the outset, Dr. Chetan P. Sarode, IQAC coordinator, welcomed the Chairperson of Dr. Prashant Warke and all the members. The following agenda were discussed during the meeting and it was unanimously resolved to implement them.

Agenda:

1. Previous minutes were read by Dr. Chetan Sarode and approved by all members.

2. To Discuss the Recommendation Given by NAAC Peer Team

Director Dr. Prashant Warke presents the NAAC Peer Team report. The committee reviewed the recommendations given by the NAAC Peer Team. The key points included Strategic Plan to be developed for future, Improve research output, Increase industry-academia collaboration, Enhance OBE implementation, Alumni engagement, etc. After discussion members suggested taking necessary actions and complying all the recommendations given by NAAC peer team with in time limit.

5. Discussion on Faculty Development Programs (FDPs)

Director Dr. Prashant Warke convinced all members of the importance of the FDP and continuous faculty training will be emphasized during year. Proposals for FDPs related to computer, curriculum development, IT return etc were made.

After discussion members suggested minimum two FDPs per semester to be organized in Institute as well as encourage faculty members to apply for like NPTEL, SWAYAM FDP to develop the skills.

6. To Review the Work of Physical Infrastructure Development

Dr. Prashant Warke informed all the members about the new construction of the college. All the members inspected the progress of infrastructure development including classrooms, computer lab, elevator etc.

After inspection of infrastructure the members suggested to complete the work as soon as possible.

7. To Discuss the Admission Process AY 2025–26

Dr. Prashant Warke told all the members that the admission process of all programs will now begin and we are now focusing on the admission process. The strategies to enhance admissions were discussed, including banner, hoardings, alumni references, college visits etc.

8. Update on Research Publications

Minutes of 31st IQAC Meeting

Agenda:

Minutes:

The meeting of Internal Quality Assurance Cell was held on 31st October 2025 at 4 pm in IQAC cell. The meeting was chaired by Hon'ble. Dr. Prashant Warke, Director of Godavari Institute of Management and Research.

At the outset, Dr. Chetan P. Sarode, IQAC coordinator, welcomed the Chairperson of Dr. Prashant Warke and all the members. The following agenda were discussed during the meeting and it was unanimously resolved to implement them.

1. Previous meeting minutes were read by Dr. Chetan Sarode and approved by all IQAC members.
2. **Agenda:** Review of Academic Activities.

Discussion: The IQAC members reviewed the academic activities. All Program Coordinators presented detailed reports on syllabus completion and overall academic progress within their respective programs. The reports highlighted the status of course delivery, including the number of lectures and practical sessions conducted, coverage of syllabus as per the academic calendar.

Members noted the efforts of faculty in maintaining consistent academic schedules and told to conduct internal exams.

3. **Agenda:** Discussion on Proposed Increase in MCA Program Intake

Discussion: The Director Dr. Prashant Warke addressed the committee regarding the proposal to increase the intake capacity from 120 to 180 of the Master of Computer Applications (MCA) program. The Director highlighted that, due to the growing demand for skilled professionals in the computer and IT sector, it is imperative to expand the program to accommodate more students. Committee members discussed the feasibility of the proposed increase, taking into account availability of infrastructure, laboratory resources, and the need to maintain academic standards. It was agreed that a detailed proposal, including resource requirements and a plan to ensure quality education, would be prepared for submission to the University authorities for approval.

4. **Agenda:** Review and discussion of the BBA program closure

Discussion: The Director, Dr. Prashant Warke, informed the members that the proposal to close the BBA program was based on two key factors: increasing competition from similar programs offered by other institutions and a consistent decline in student enrollment. Despite various initiatives undertaken to enhance admissions, enrollment numbers have remained low over recent years, rendering the program financially and academically unsustainable in the long term.

Members deliberated on the possible implications of the program's closure, with particular reference to its impact on currently enrolled students, faculty members, and overall institutional planning. In response, the Director assured the members that a structured "teach-out" plan would be implemented, allowing all existing students to complete their degrees without any disruption to their academic progression. It was decided to close the BBA program.

5. **Agenda:** Discussion on Organizing a Faculty Development Program (FDP) under the PM-USHA Scheme

Discussion: Dr. Chetan Sarode provided an update regarding the Faculty Development Program (FDP) under the PM-USHA scheme. He informed the committee that the application for conducting the FDP had been submitted to the University and has been officially approved.

The committee suggested preparing an official brochure for the Faculty Development Program (FDP), detailing the program objectives and proposed schedule. Responsibilities for planning, resource allocation, and communication with participants were assigned to the respective faculty coordinators to ensure the smooth and effective execution of the program.

6. **Agenda:** Discussion on Planning and Conduct of University External Examinations.

Discussion: Dr. Chetan Sarode informed the members that the University External Examinations are to be conducted next month. The committee discussed the necessary preparations to ensure smooth conduct of the examinations, including scheduling, allocation of invigilators, and adherence to University guidelines.

7. **Agenda:** Discussion on Procurement of Library Books and Resources.

Discussion: The Librarian presented a prioritized list of recommended books and journals prepared based on faculty recommendations as per new syllabus requirement. The committee reviewed the proposed list and approved the procurement within the sanctioned budget. It was further resolved that future library acquisitions would be aligned with academic requirements to support effective teaching, learning, and research activities.

8. **Agenda:** Application for NPTEL exam center at institute.

Discussion: Dr. Neelima Warke informed the members that for second-year MCA students, the NPTEL examination is a compulsory component of the curriculum. She emphasized that establishing an NPTEL examination centre at the institute would be

highly beneficial for students, as it would provide convenient access and support for appearing in the examination.

Members acknowledged the benefits of establishing the centre, including providing students with easier access to online certification exams, promoting digital learning, and enhancing the institute's visibility in academic and research circles. It was agreed that the IQAC would coordinate with the administration to prepare the necessary documents and submit the formal application to NPTEL authorities.

9. Timely subjects

- Dr. Prashant Warke suggested planning for Industrial visit at National level.

Since the business was completely transacted; the coordinator proposed vote of thanks and with the permission of the Chair, declared the closure of the meeting.

At the outset, Dr. Chetan P. Sarode, IQAC coordinator, welcomed the Chairperson of Dr. Prashant Warke and all the members. The following agenda were discussed during the meeting and it was unanimously resolved to implement them.

2. **Agenda:** To organize annual gathering in the college

Discussion: The IQAC Coordinator introduced the agenda item regarding the organization of the Annual Gathering for the academic year 2025–26.

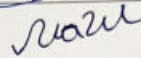
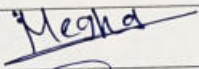


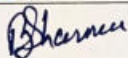
