Spark 2024

Report on Sport Event (20 Feb 2024 – 23 Feb 2024)

Sport pertains to any form of physical activity or game, often competitive and organized, that aims to use, maintain, or improve physical ability and skills while providing enjoyment to participants and, in some cases, entertainment to spectators. Sports can, through casual or organized participation, improve participants' physical health. Hundreds of sports exist, from those between single contestants, through to those with hundreds of simultaneous participants, either in teams or competing as individuals. In certain sports such as racing, many contestants may compete, simultaneously or consecutively, with one winner; in others, the contest (a match) is between two sides, each attempting to exceed the other. Some sports allow a "tie" or "draw", in which there is no single winner; others provide tie-breaking methods to ensure one winner and one loser.

A Sport organized by Godavari Institute of Management and Research, Jalgaon. On the Spark 2024. The event was inaugurated by **Director Dr. Prashant Warke Sir**, and **Principal Dr. Neelima Warke Mam**. The Event was conducted for both the girls and boys categories.

At the commencement of the event, **Dr. Prashant warke sir** expressed her views on outdoor games and there are many tactics and strategies in chess and a good player should know most of them, but it is not the case of sitting and learning the tactics by heart. It is an incredibly beneficial pastime, because playing chess results in better brain function, improved memory and cognitive abilities, strategic thinking and attention improvement.

He further said that on the course of many games, players develop an almost natural feeling of when to use a certain strategy or tactic – this is where the benefits of improved memory shine – players can quickly remember and use different strategies or tactics. The best part is that this benefit is not only limited

The batting side scores runs by striking the ball bowled at one of the wickets with the bat and then running between the wickets, while the bowling and fielding side tries to prevent this (by preventing the ball from leaving the field, and getting the ball to either wicket) and dismiss each batter (so they are "out"). Means of dismissal include being bowled, when the ball hits the stumps and dislodges the bails, and by the fielding side either catching the ball after it is hit by the bat, but before it hits the ground, or hitting a wicket with the ball before a batter can cross the crease in front of the wicket. They communicate with two off-field scorers who record the match's statistical information.

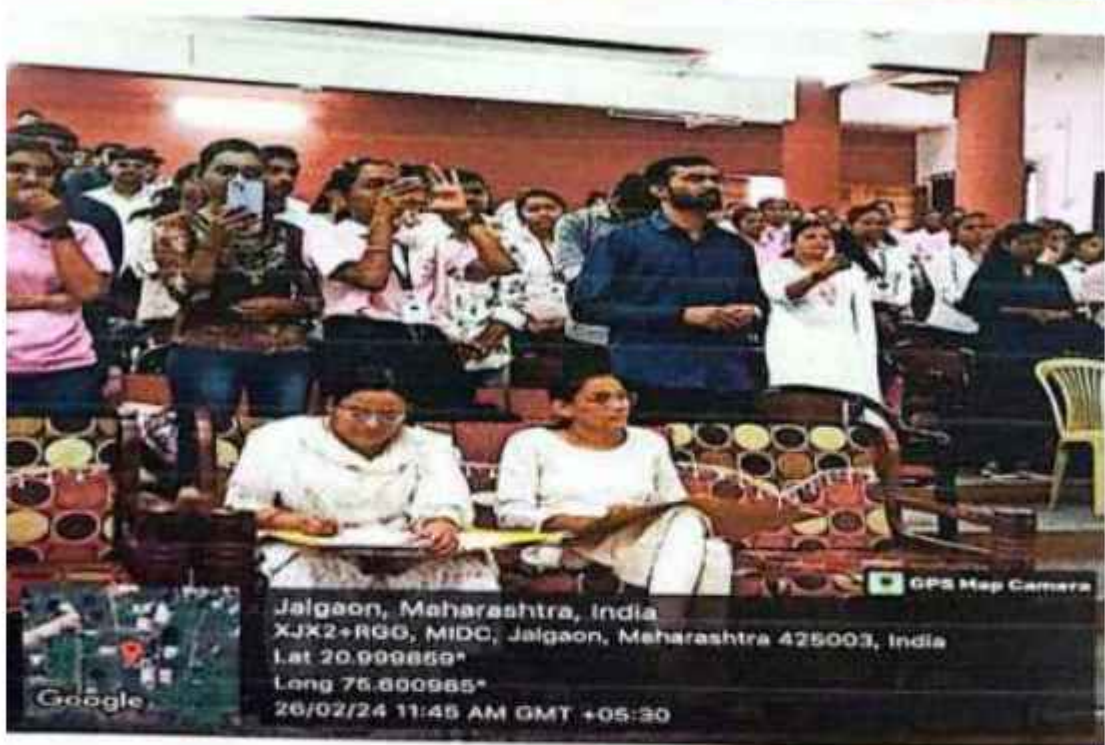

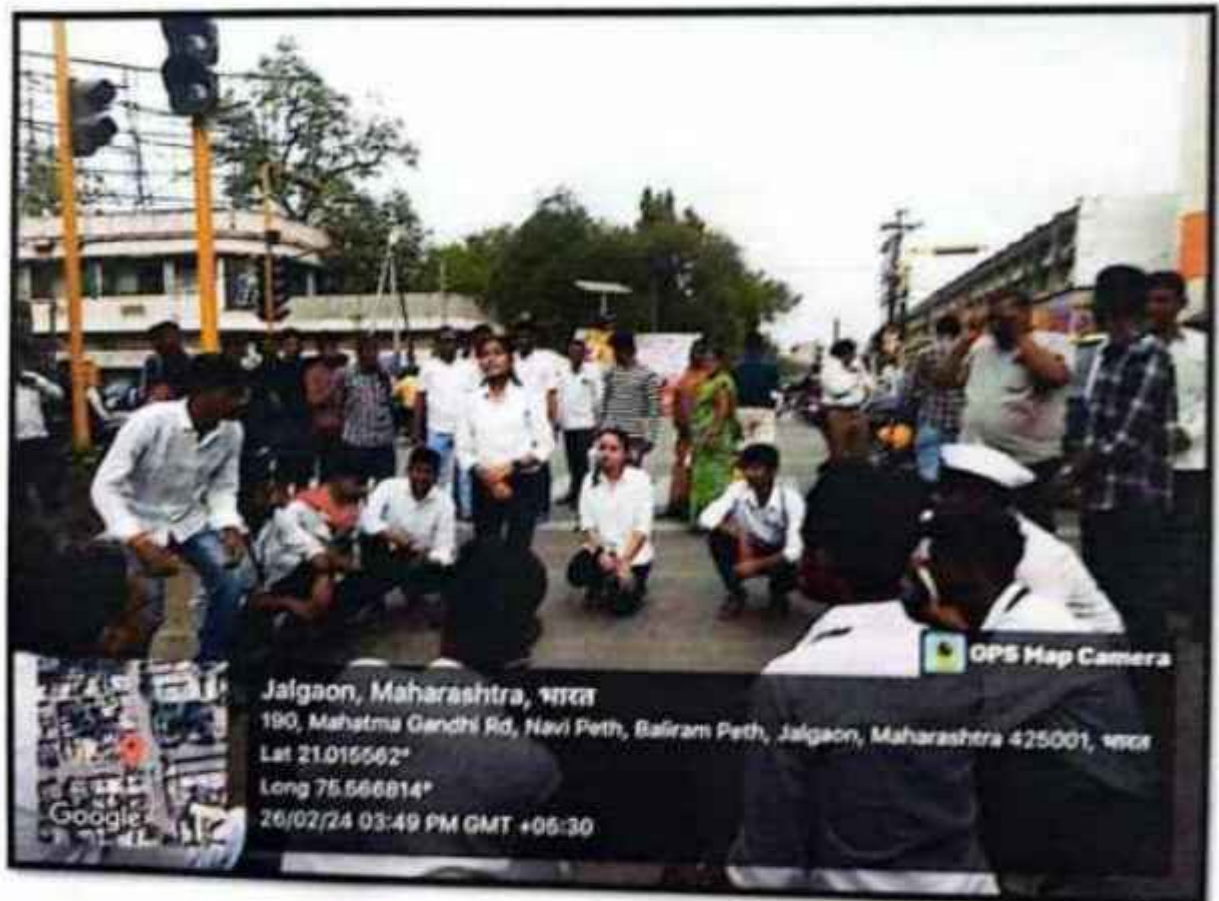
